Sustainability Team: All our teammates have a role to play in helping to protect the environment, managing the impacts of our work on the air, water, soil and on biodiversity. As a functional area, environmental management is under the responsibility of the national Sustainability team, which is part of a broader department led by our SVP Innovation, Sustainability and Strategy. The sustainability team works cross-functionally across our business to implement an environmental management system, which includes:

- · Ensuring compliance to environmental regulations
- Implementing programs and processes to execute the commitments in our Environmental Policy
- Overseeing audits to ensure compliance to the policy
- Taking action to address breaches
- · Ensuring continuous improvement to minimize environmental impacts
